Te Totara Primary School Fees and Donations

This week is the launch of our new Kindo online School Fees & Donations Payment system - designed to make it easy for you to manage school payments and complete Permission Forms.

Register here Click on the left blue link and register the email address the school has on file for you. If access is denied, it is most likely that we do not have your current email address recorded on your child's student profile - please contact the School Office on (07) 853-0039 to amend. You can check your child's details using the Parent Portal at: <http://www.atschool.co.nz/> Enter your user ID and Password (*provided with your child's Learning Plan last week*)

- Go to My Child
- Click on Contact Details

You can pay your school donation, and other school costs all online. We'll be adding more items as the year progresses.

- You can make payments or purchases when it suits you... anytime, anywhere.
- You no longer have to rely on sending cash and forms with your children, looking up bank account numbers, amounts and details, or visiting the School Office. Just login and click. Even small amounts can be paid quickly and securely through Kindo.
- You can use Kindo as a school savings account so you have school funds when you need them. Or choose to pay at the time by making an instant transfer from Internet banking (no fees) or by using a credit or debit card (fees apply).

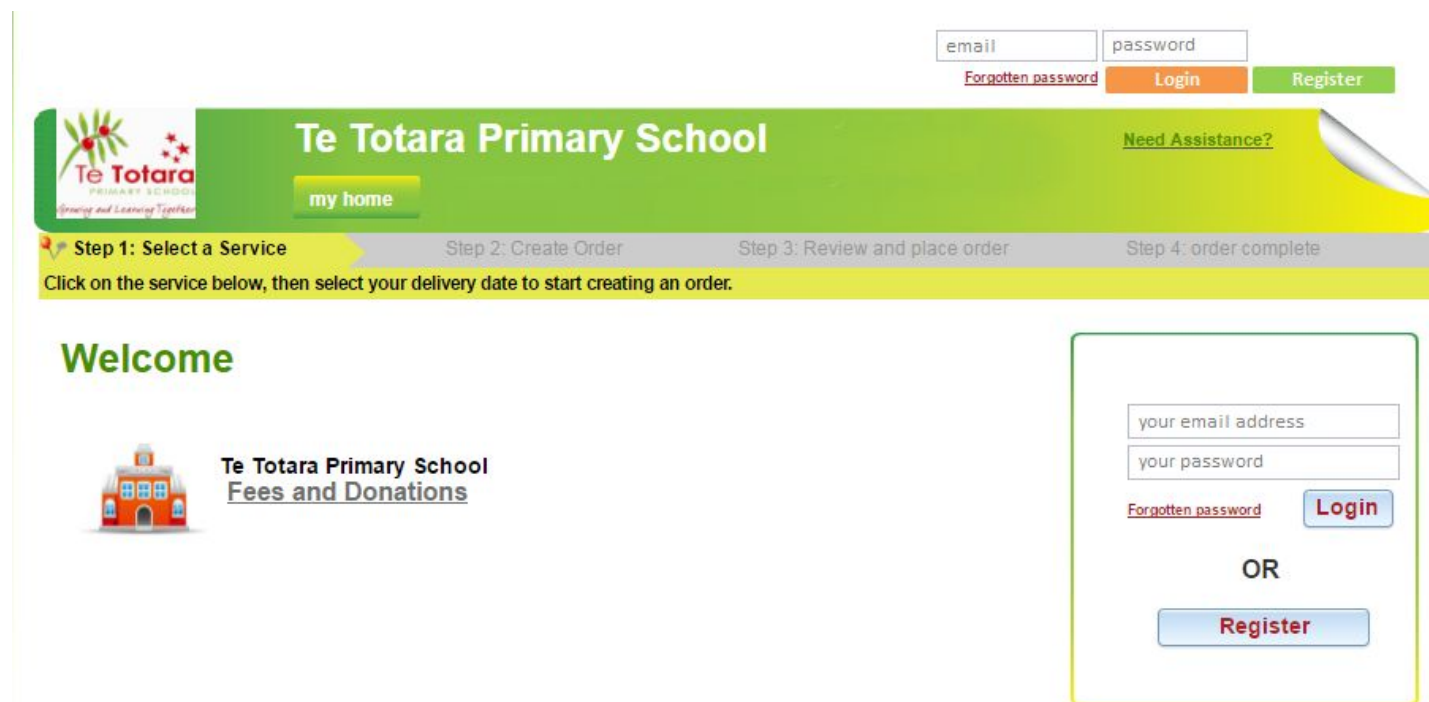

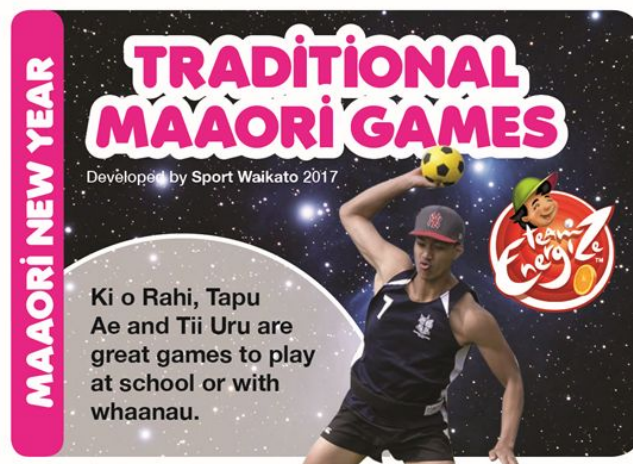
