## **EMERGENCY FIRE DRILL EVACUATION TRIAL - MONDAY 12TH MARCH, 2018 @ 1.30pm**

We hold trials to make sure everyone is safe so we are having our first one this year on **Monday 12th March, 2018 @ 1.30pm**. This involves a continual ringing of the bell, or by a speaker system telling us to evacuate the buildings. Our assembly point is on the tennis courts, where we take the school roll and ensure all people on our site are accounted for. We will talk to our students about the trial beforehand.

## **LOCK DOWN TRIAL - MONDAY 19TH MARCH, 2018 @ 11.15am**

We have an obligation to trial this system in order for the school to be as prepared as possible for any such emergency. Our staff are trained to look after our children, reassure them and ensure both their physical and emotional safety. We have noticed that the more often we have these trials, the more familiar we all are with the systems. We will talk to our students about the trial beforehand.

## **HOW WE CONTACT YOU IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY AT SCHOOL**

We will use social messaging, including Facebook, the School App and website. Also, we will phone if necessary, so it's a good idea to make sure you keep your contact details up-to-date with the School Office. It is important that you follow any directions given, especially around rushing to school if you hear of an emergency. This can cause congestion, confusion and stress. Please note that in a real incident that NZ Police will take control of access to and from the school, while we look after our children.

## ILLNESS AT SCHOOL

Even though we are now coming into Autumn there are a few bugs around which are affecting our children as well as staff.

If your child is sick please keep them at home until they are well. If your child has diarrhoea or vomiting we ask that they do not return to school unless they are well and have had **no further diarrhoea or vomiting for 48 hours prior to returning** – these bugs can be highly contagious. Thank you for your assistance in this.

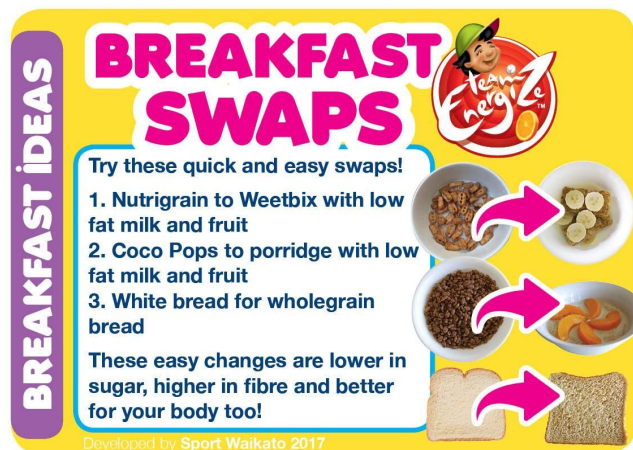
