MEAT & MEAT ALTERNATIVES

Ingredients:

- 1 cup smoked fish – crumbled
- 200g light cream cheese – softened
- ½ red onion - finely diced
- 1 stalk celery – finely diced
- 1 tbsp parsley or chives - chopped
- 1 tsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tsp lemon juice

In a bowl, mix the cream cheese, onion, celery, parsley or chives, Worcestershire sauce and lemon juice.

Fold the smoked fish into the cream cheese mixture. Cover, and chill in the fridge.

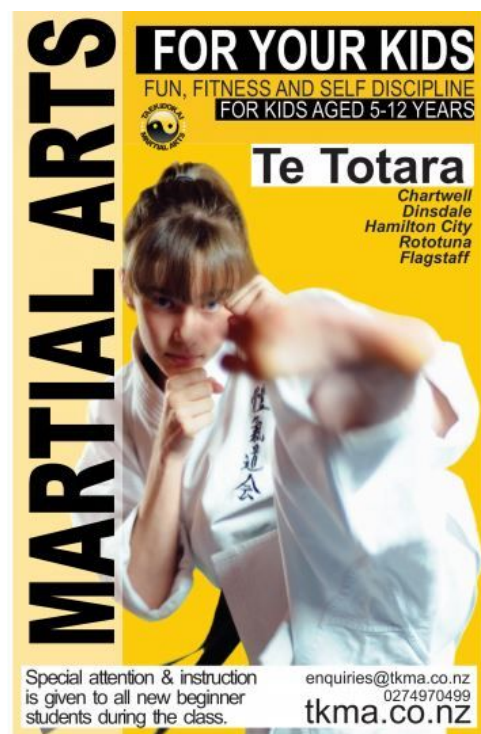
COMMUNITY NOTICES:
