This week our children from Orion and Milky Way attended assembly and this week our children from Orion 9 have shared.

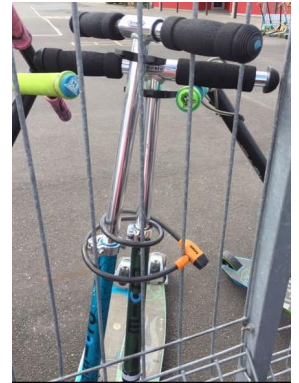
LOCKING OF BIKES AND SCOOTERS

Pre-schoolers may also enrol and there will be classes if we have enough interest for pre-schoolers.

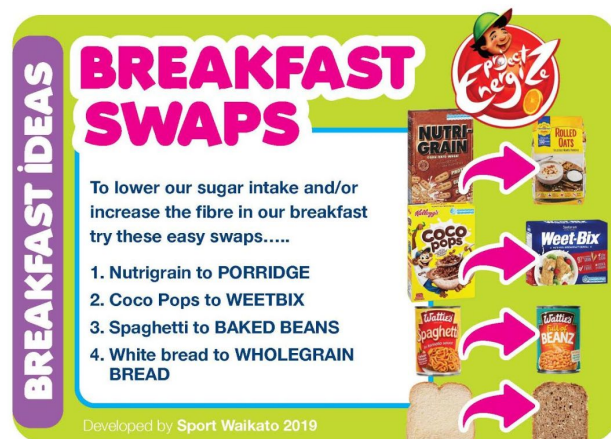
