## LOCATION AND LOCKING OF BIKES AND SCOOTERS

Last week our school was the target of theft, several scooters were taken from the bike rack area near the pool. These scooters were unlocked. We have reviewed our protocols in this area in order to reduce the risk of further incidents happening.

#### Any scooters <u>without a lock</u>, must be parked on the internal fence beside the Marama (yellow) block.

All bikes that come to school must have a bike lock that is used correctly by your child, so they can be secure on the bike racks during the school day.

Although we do have some security cameras scattered throughout the school our best advice is to **PLEASE LOCK YOUR CHILD'S BIKE OR SCOOTER.** 



Individual scooters are extremely difficult to identify on CCTV as there are 100's of scooters parked along our fence line at any one time.

If your child intends to play on the playground after school for a short time, please ask them to go and get their bike/scooter first and have it with them.

Note: We would expect that all of our children who are not enrolled at After School Care would have left the school premises by 3.15pm.

## **ILLNESS AT SCHOOL**

The School Office has seen a few cases of diarrhoea and vomiting amongst students at Te Totara Primary School. As this can be very easily transmitted, please ensure all unwell students are kept at home until **48 hours after the diarrhoea and/or vomiting has stopped.** It is important to encourage good hand washing and drying. Please see a Doctor if vomiting and/or diarrhoea is severe or the illness does not improve.



#### **UNWELL CHILDREN WHO NEED TO GO HOME**

Our Admin team and teaching staff act in the very best interests of your child and their well-being is paramount. When children arrive at the School Office to be assessed, and depending on the situation, most of the children are offered a rest in our Wellness Room and re-assessed before a phone call home; often they return to their classroom.

We understand many of our families have work commitments however, if you are phoned by the school to collect your child from school due to illness, it would be appreciated if you could arrange for their collection as soon as possible. For the privacy of other students, the School Office staff will collect your child from the Wellness Room when you arrive. If your child is sick, please keep them at home until they are well.



#### LATE ARRIVALS (AFTER 8.55AM)

Just a reminder to our families that our school day starts promptly with the bell at 8.55am.

The teachers then greet their classes and complete the school attendance register which is then relayed to the school office.

We understand there may be rare occasions where your child arrives

late at school (after 8.55am), we require families to report to the School Office for the child to be signed-in using the VisTab tablet and

issued with a "Late Card" prior to heading to their learning areas. Have you ever arrived at a meeting late, everyone is settled in their chair, the presenter has welcomed them and is now outlining what the day has in store...... and as you walk in they all turn and look at you? That is what it can be like for your child when they arrive late at school and their class is all settled. So please, we ask parents to ensure their children arrive at school with at least five minutes to spare, for them to organise themselves by

hanging up their school bag and sorting their book bag independently.



We appreciate your effort in ensuring your child/ren arrive at school in good time before the first bell at 8.55am.
