As you know last Friday our teachers attended the Te Pae Here Teacher Only Day at Rototuna High School which was a terrific day of learning for all 500 teachers. Ngāti Wairere was in attendance for the early morning Pōwhiri supported by the RHS Kapa Haka Group. It was a beautiful opening for the day, made all the more special by seeing a number of ex Te Totara students in the Kapa Haka group performing with such pride and confidence.

A workshop I attended focused on using the Ngaa Puna o Ngaati Wairere website https://www.ngaapuna.org/ as a focus for the NZ Histories Curriculum by investigating the area we live in. I also had great pleasure in listening to Wiremu Puke sharing his huge knowledge of the pre European Hamilton area. Dr Michael Johnston, the Chairperson of the Curriculum Review Board and Erica Stanford, the Minister of Education, finished off the day with a keynote speech about Cognitive Overload and the thinking behind the new curriculum focus on Structured Literacy and Maths. I know our teachers have been enjoying sharing what they learned with their teams and colleagues back at school this week. This annual Teacher Only Day is always a highlight of our Community of Learning.

Our TOPA (Talents of the Pacific Academy) leader, Landy, has been asked to provide a group of students for the halftime performance at the quarter final Chief's match this Friday. 14 of our Te Totara TOPA students from Year 2 upwards have joined this performance group. They are practising hard each evening so if you are going to the game please keep an eye out for our fantastic tamariki dancing their hearts out.

A reminder that school starts and teachers start teaching at **8.55am sharp** It is important for children to be here before this time to get ready for the day. We encourage our families to arrive at school around <u>8.30am</u>, which gives plenty of time for your child to unpack their school bag and have a play before the bell goes.

LOCKDOWN TRIAL HELD - WEDNESDAY 5TH JUNE, 2024 (YESTERDAY)

Yesterday morning, we had an unannounced Lockdown Trial for teachers and students to test and make sure our systems worked well. It is important that we check our Lockdown procedures every 6 months to ensure the wellbeing of all, should we ever be in a real Lockdown situation. We were delighted with what happened, everyone reacted in a very appropriate manner. We are so proud of the calm and settled way the students are, just following the directions of their teachers, even the nine 'Guest Teachers' we had in our school. After the Lockdown practise Mrs Stewart messaged everyone through our Te Totara School App to advise we had just finished a Lockdown practice.

HOW WE CONTACT YOU IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY AT SCHOOL

We will use social messaging, including Facebook, the School App and website. Also, we may phone if necessary, so it is a good idea to make sure you keep your contact details up-to-date. It is important that you follow any directions given, especially around rushing to school if you hear of an emergency. This can cause congestion, confusion and stress. In a real incident, the NZ Police will take control of access to and from the school, while we look after our children.

Please note: No-one will answer the front door or the school phone during Lock Down as we need to keep the phone lines open for Emergency Services to use. Everyone's safety is paramount.
