



ALL TICKETS ARE \$14.00 EACH


Children 3 years old and under are FREE, provided they are sitting on the knee of a paying adult ticket. Otherwise, you must purchase a separate ticket for them.

ENVIROSCHOOLS UPDATE

Compost Installation at Te Totara

As a school we notice a high volume of food waste going to landfill. So we explored different options and last week and a Carbon Cycle Hot Compost system was installed! Lead Enviroschools teacher Bridget McLaughlin organised the epic compost set-up. Tim and Richard @ The CarbonCycle Company came to help install their fantastic hot compost system that will turn

food and green waste gathered from the school, local preschool, cafe and retirement village into beautiful nutrient-rich food for the soil and school gardens. Students got busy with tools to construct the frame, base and walls, then learned about the 'brown and green sandwich' they would make to layer the right amount of carbon and nitrogen, keeping the compost smelling sweet and creating the perfect habitat for the FBI (fungi, bacteria and invertebrates!) to flourish. The students were a great help and had lots of fun learning about composting. Awesome!









OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2025

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website by clicking the following link: www.tetotara.school.nz

There will be two 2025 out-of-zone enrolment periods:

The First enrolment period runs from 18th December 2024 – 27th June 2025

The Second enrolment period runs from 28th June 2025 – 17th December 2025

The Board has determined the following places are likely to be available to out-of-zone students from 2024 onwards. Enrolment period of **18th December**, **2024 - 27th June**, **2025**:

10x places for New Entrants (whose 5th Birthday falls within the above enrolment period)

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

For students seeking enrolment within the above enrolment period, the deadline for receipt of out-of-zone applications is **9.00am Friday 27th September**, **2024** and should be emailed to:

receptionist@tetotara.school.nz

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for this year. Students who live in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school.

Applications from out-of-zone students will be processed in the following order of priority:

- a) **First priority** must be given to students who have been accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the school and approved by the Secretary of Education*.
 - * This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Ministry of Education
- b) **Second priority** must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.
- c) Third priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a former student of the school.
- d) Fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- e) **Fifth priority** must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the Board of the school, or a child of a member of the Board of the school.
- f) Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot supervised by a Justice of the Peace, a Practicing Lawyer or a Police Officer in accordance under Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989.

If a ballot for out-of-zone is required, it will be held on <u>Friday 11th October</u>, <u>2024</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Wednesday 11th October**, <u>2024</u>.




