



# CHICKENPOX (Varicella)

We have a number of students away with chickenpox. According to Te Whatu Ora Health New 7ealand:

- Early signs are tiredness, a fever and general aches and pains. Spots appear with a blister on top of each spot.
- Time between exposure and sickness is 10-21 days after being exposed.
- This disease is spread through the air by sneezing or coughing, by touching the chickenpox blisters of an infected person or by having contact with weeping blisters.
- Chickenpox is contagious from 1-2 days before the blisters appear.
- Exclusion from school is 1 week from the date of the

appearance of the rash, or until blisters have dried. If you are unsure whether your child should return to school, please

# **OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2025**

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website by clicking the following link: <a href="www.tetotara.school.nz">www.tetotara.school.nz</a>

There will be two 2025 out-of-zone enrolment periods:

The First enrolment period runs from 18th December 2024 – 27th June 2025

The Second enrolment period runs from 28th June 2025 – 17th December 2025

The Board has determined the following places are likely to be available to out-of-zone students from 2025 onwards. Enrolment period of 18th December, 2024 - 27th June, 2025:

**10x places for New Entrants** (whose 5th Birthday falls within the above enrolment period)

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

For students seeking enrolment within the above enrolment period, the deadline for receipt of out-of-zone applications is 9.00am Friday 27th September, 2024 and should be emailed to:

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for this year. Students who live in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot supervised by a Justice of the Peace, a Practicing Lawyer or a Police Officer in accordance under Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989.

If a ballot for out-of-zone is required, it will be held on Friday 11th October, 2024. Parents will be informed of the outcome by Wednesday 11th October, 2024.

#### STUDENTS LEAVING SCHOOL EARLY FOR ANY REASON

Just a reminder that if you are taking your child out of school for any reason during the school day (including leaving after Friday assembly), please sign them out through the ipad in the School Office. This is a Health & Safety requirement, should we have a LockDown or Fire Drill then we will know that your child is not on our school site.



You will also need to do this if you take your child home early after school assembly on Friday. Thank you.
