Kia Ora Whānau,

As we near the end of the year I just want to thank all of our community for their support and understanding. We know as a school we are constantly evolving and needing to change things to suit the community and our children. This term I have seen so much joy in our celebrations and in our children's learning. It has been so wonderful to see so much progress in learning and children putting in loads of effort. Our Structured Literacy BSLA programme in the junior school has been progressing and evolving well over the past couple of years. We are also looking at other initiatives higher up in the school like 'The CODE' that follows on from BSLA. Over the course of next year we will be continuing our Maths PD to support teacher capability and consistency across our school. This will have a direct focus on number knowledge and problem solving skills. We will share more around this in the New Year when we start teaching. Currently our children will be completing some testing as the teachers are updating their Learning Plans.

Procedure for Concerns

School and home are a partnership and we want to work together for each child to reach their potential. If there are any concerns throughout the year with your child, please contact your child's classroom teacher in the first instance. If you feel you need to speak with someone else, then make contact with the Team Leader of that area. It is very important to follow this process. Your child's classroom teacher should always be the first person to talk to. There are many things that happen for children during their day and if you are concerned it is best to email the classroom teacher with a time to meet to discuss your concern. We need to make sure we have all the information before we discuss the concern and work in partnership to grow the capacity of our children.

Term 4 is also a good reminder that for anytime the children are outside, we are making sure our children have their hats on. **NO HAT, NO PLAY**. We have a number of children that are not wearing their hats. **Could you please make sure your child has a named school hat to wear at school.**

COLLECTING UNWELL CHILDREN FROM SCHOOL

Just a little reminder..... If your child is unwell and you have received a phone call from the School Office, please sign your child out using the VisTab tablet and then a **staff member will take you to the wellness room** to collect your child. For the privacy of other students who may be in the wellness room, please do not just walk in without being accompanied by a member of our staff.

If your child is sick please keep them at home until they are well. If your child has diarrhoea or vomiting we ask that they do not return to school unless they are well and have had **no further diarrhoea or vomiting for 48 hours prior to returning – these bugs can be highly contagious.** Thank you for your assistance in this.
