We are enjoying some fabulous weather at the moment which made our Learning Plan interview days last week go very smoothly. Thank you so much to you all for picking up your children at 2.00pm, allowing these important conversations with our families to begin promptly at 2.30pm. It is great to see our families catching up in the sunshine whilst waiting for their interview. Another chance to reconnect as a community while building and strengthening the home-school partnership.

Please make sure if you have any concerns to make time to see your child's teacher. We are always here to help and make time to work through any concerns. Children are always going to have some not so positive interactions with each other, but it is how we deal with that and model it which makes it a learning experience. We must work in partnership to support our children.

One of the many highlights in my day is when I get to go around the classrooms and see all the children happily engaging in their learning. On any given day there are many aspects of the curriculum covered and I enjoy talking with the children about their new learning. Two questions I like to ask them are: what are they proud of today? and what have they learnt today that will help them tomorrow? These are great questions to ask children at the end of the day and it can also help not just in learning but with peer relationships and how they interact with others.

Term 2 is fast approaching and we have two teachers that are leaving us. Anna Livingstone and Dori Villasol-Aonso will be finishing at the end of this term. Anna is moving on to concentrate on her family and Dori is retiring from full-time teaching. We will honor these two wonderful teachers towards the end of the term. Their teaching jobs have been advertised and once appointments have been made I will notify their classroom families and the community.

I wanted to thank all those parents that were able to attend our evening with Rob Cope. We will be sending out some 2 minute videos every Tuesday from Rob so please take time to view them. We will also let families know when and what we are teaching at school.






LOST & FOUND PROPERTY BIN

2025 FEES, SPORTS REGISTRATIONS & DONATIONS PAID VIA KINDO

This online system allows you to pay for our school's fees (Mathletics/Mathseeds, Voluntary School Donation, Lost Library Book Costs etc) and is also the ONLY way to register/pay for your child for sports teams.

Please Note: Aquatics will be charged after your child's class has had their lessons.

- Voluntary School Donation (\$120.00 first/only child / \$60.00 each sibling)
- Mathletics/Mathseeds



*** PLEASE NOTE: If you do not receive confirmation from KINDO you have "successfully registered", then you have not completed the sign-up process. Your item may still be in your cart, please ensure you complete the process ***

OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2025

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website **www.tetotara.school.nz**

The Board has determined the following places are likely to be available to OUTZ students from Term 3, 2025 onwards. Enrolment period: **28th June - 17th December 2025**:

20 places for Year 0 students (whose 5th Birthday falls within the above enrolment period)

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

For students seeking enrolment within the above enrolment period, the deadline for receipt of OUTZ applications is **1.00pm on Friday 11th April**, **2025** and should be emailed to:

receptionist@tetotara.school.nz

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately. Students who live in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school.

Applications from OUTZ students will be processed in accordance with the Ministry of Education Order of Priority. Please visit our school website www.tetotara.school.nz under "Out-of-Zone Enrolments" for further information. Click the red link: OUTZ Enrolment Form

If the number of OUTZ applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot supervised by a Justice of the Peace, a Practicing Lawyer or a Police Officer in accordance with Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989.

If a ballot for OUTZ is required, it will be held on <u>Thursday 24th April, 2025</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Wednesday 30th April, 2025**.

Note: If your child is successful in gaining an OUTZ place, in order to comply with the MOE criteria, your child MUST start school before the end of the 2025 school year or they will forfeit their OUTZ place.

SMART WATCHES REMINDER

Smart watches are able to be worn at school for the purpose of telling the time only. If the watch is used as a communication or recording device then your child will be asked to put it in the teachers desk at the beginning of each day and collect it before leaving school at the end of the day. Your child's teacher may ask that the watch is kept at home if there are any continuing issues.



Please remember if you need to get a message to your child at school then it is best to contact the School Office, and the office staff will make sure your child gets the message. This allows your child to focus on their learning without interruption.


