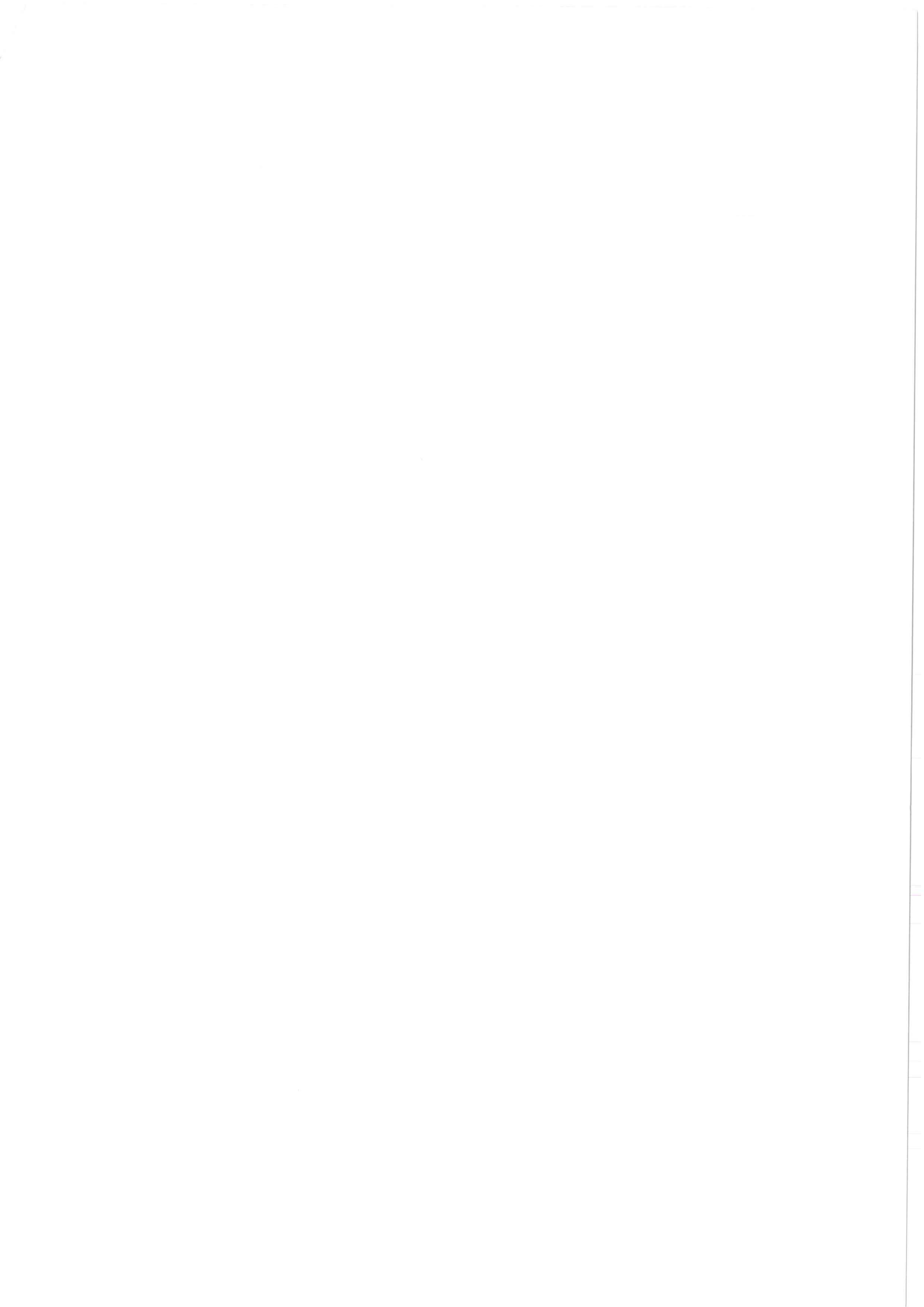

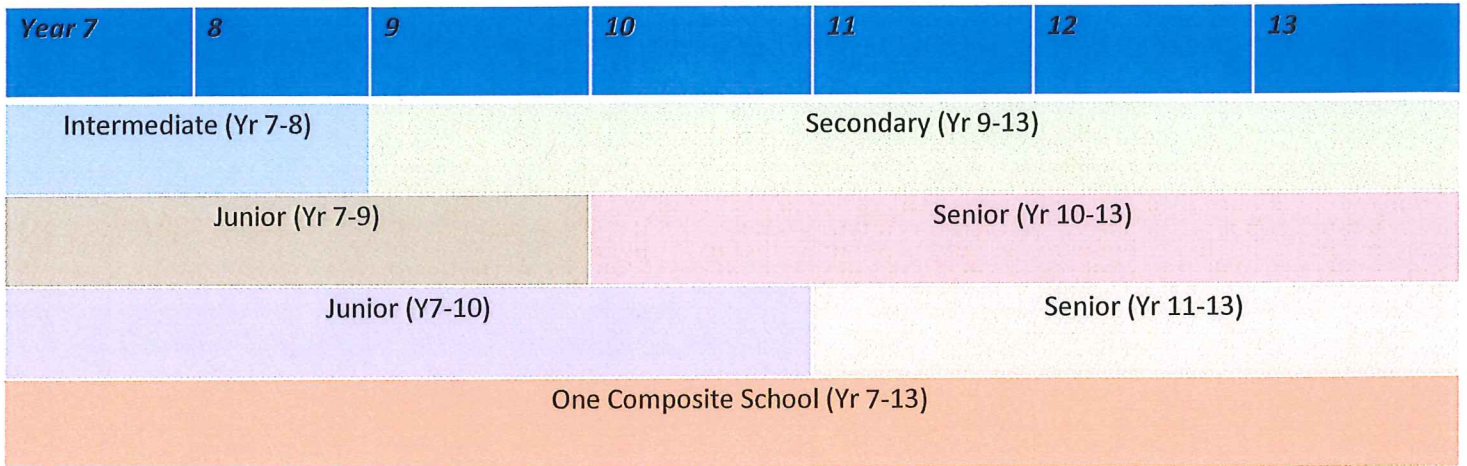

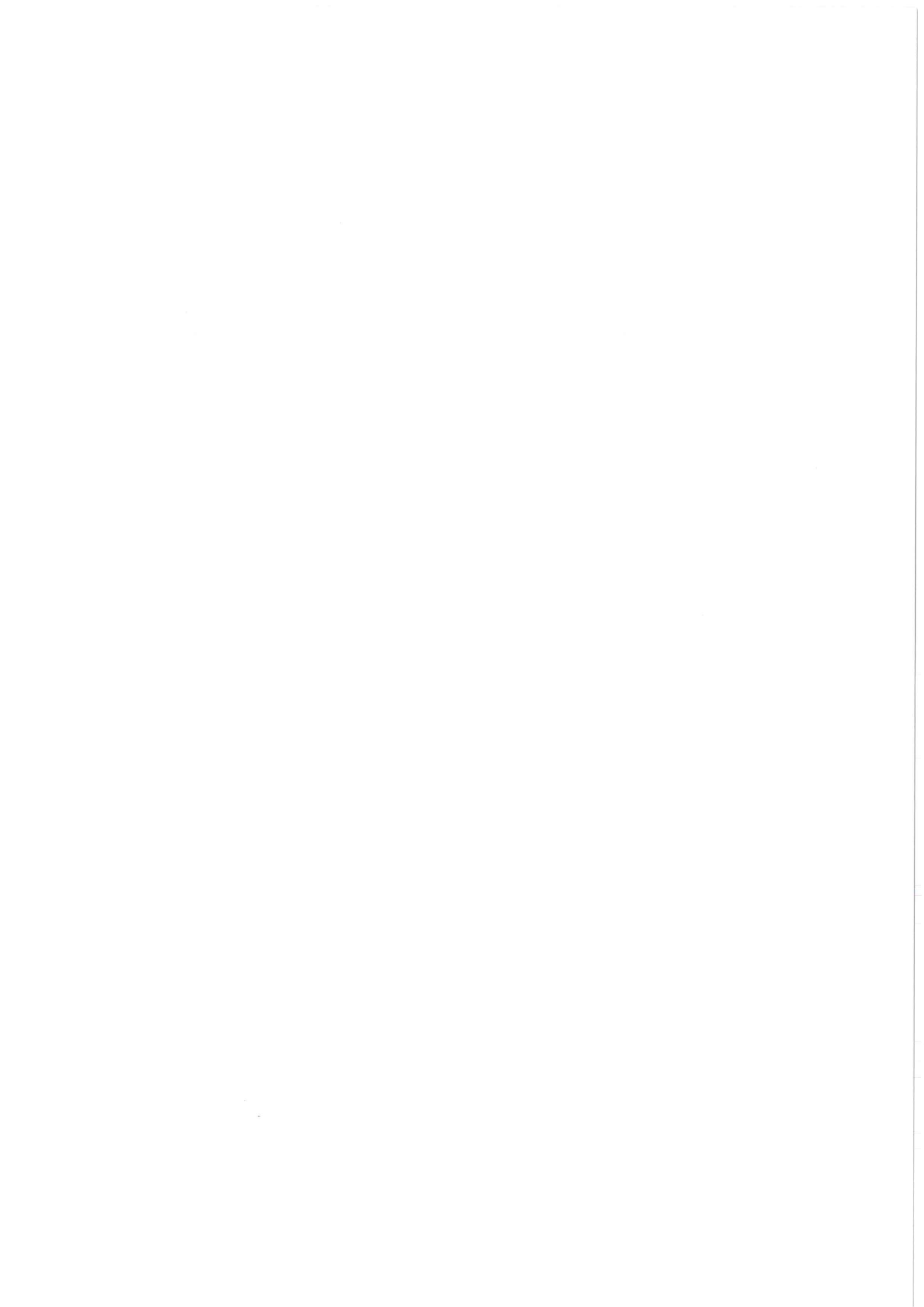


Y7-13 Schooling Possibilities

Enrolment in the new school(s) is likely to be staged – junior levels first, then senior levels (eg - Yrs 11, 12 and 13) to follow in consecutive years



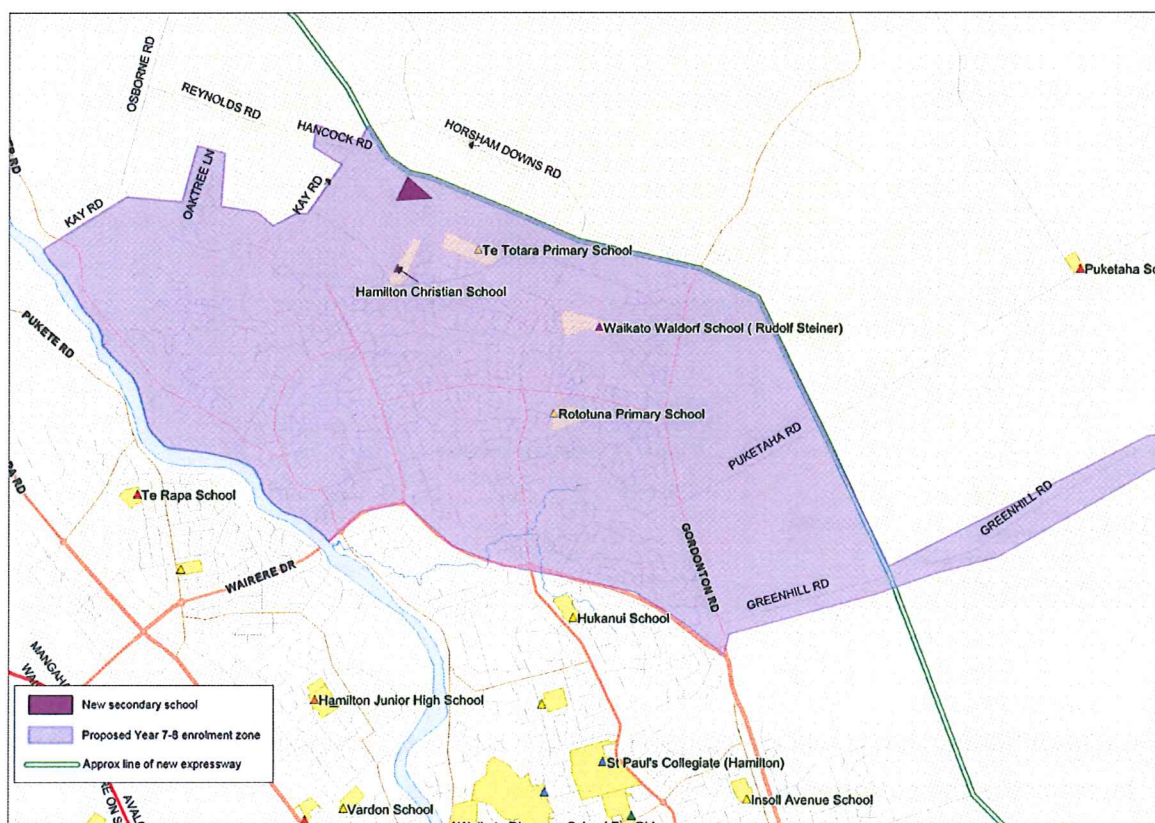

Year 7 to 13 Schools – Proposed Enrolment Scheme ‘Home-zones’

Proposed Yr 1-8 Home-zone

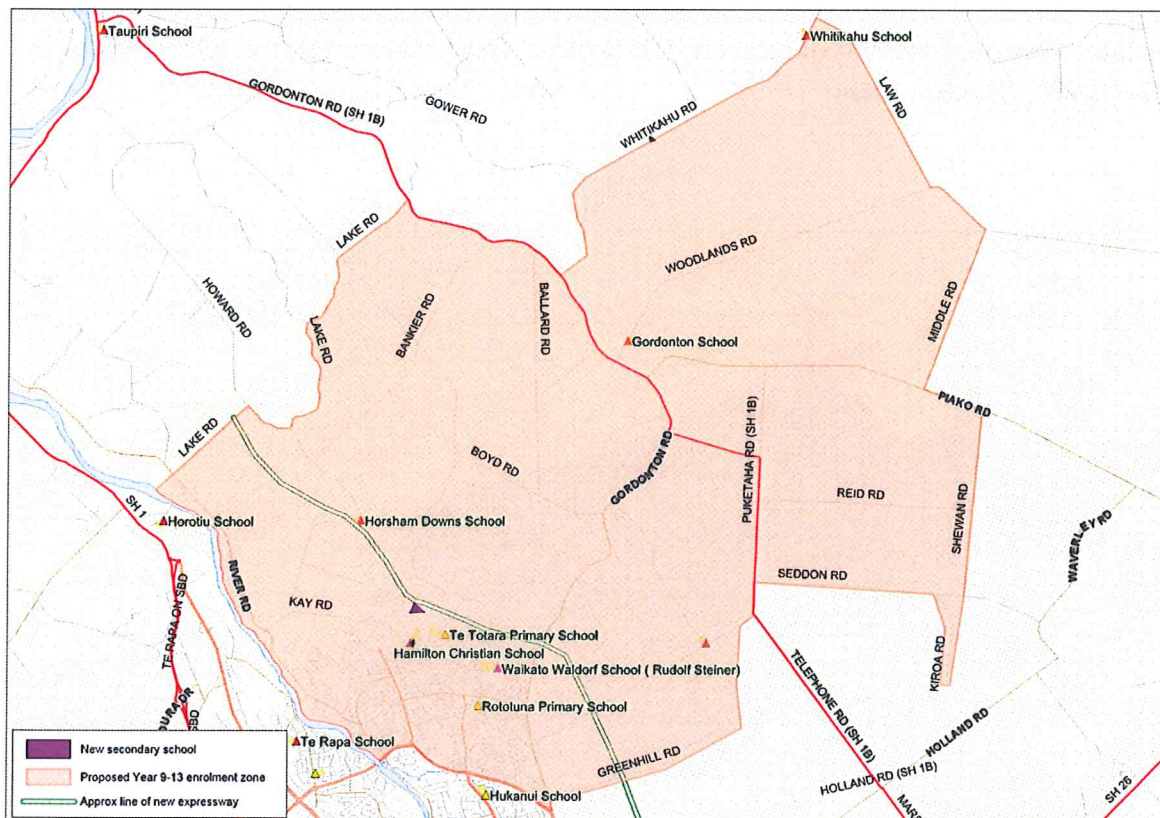
From Waikato River (eastern side only) following Wairere Drive to Gordonton Rd. Then to Greenhill Rd (includes all of Greenhill Rd). From proposed Greenhill Rd Under-bridge follow Waikato Expressway north to proposed Kay Rd Over-bridge. Then follow Kay Rd to River Rd (includes Oaktree Lane and Hancock Rd) then direct to Waikato River and follow Waikato River back to Wairere Drive.



Final school ‘home-zones’ will be advised by public notice following formal establishment by the Minister and confirmation of transport boundaries.

Proposed Yr 9-13 Home-zone

From Waikato River (eastern side only) follow Wairere Drive to Gordonton Rd. Then to Greenhill Rd - from the end of Greenhill Rd to the Puketaha/Telephone Rd Intersection. Along Puketaha Rd to Shewan Rd to Piako Rd. Then Piako Rd to Middle Rd to Woodlands Rd to Law Rd to Whitiakahu Rd along to Gordonton Road Intersection. Along Gordonton Rd to Lake Rd Intersection. Follow Lake Rd to Western By-pass, then to Waikato River and following Waikato River back to Wairere Drive.



Final school 'home-zones' will be advised by public notice following formal establishment by the Minister and confirmation of school transport zones.
